

Brushes Overview

Gallery Controls



Left to right: Plays back every brush stroke and change in sequence. Sends image to Photos, Email, Flickr or creates a copy or emails image or "actions" files. Deletes the current image. Shows small thumbnails of all images saved in the gallery. Creates a new canvas to paint on and puts you in canvas mode.


Gallery Label




This label accompanies each gallery image. You edit the Title and Name fields (see Canvas Controls, Properties). The date is generated automatically.

Canvas Controls, Top and Bottom



 Saves the current image to the gallery. It can be opened later for more work. All layers are saved, but undo's and redo's are not saved.

 Click to import images from the Photo Libraries on your iPad.



Click to set properties or create a duplicate file. Properties to set are, Title, Name, and Orientation.

Canvas Controls: Bottom of screen



Left to right: Brings up color selector, samples colors on the screen, fills a layer with selected color



Left to right: brush tool selector, brush or eraser properties, eraser tool selector



Left to right: undo, redo, layers.

Layers



Erase selected layer, combine selected layer with the previous layer, duplicate selected layer, delete selected layer, add a new layer.



Move and rotate selected layer, flip selected layer across the vertical, flip selected layer across the horizontal.



This control is a slider that sets the transparency of the selected layer.



These buttons set the "mode" or way that the selected layer interacts with other layers. Normal is opaque, experiment with the others to get interesting effects.
